MOVIE & ACTIVITY: THE PAGEMASTER!

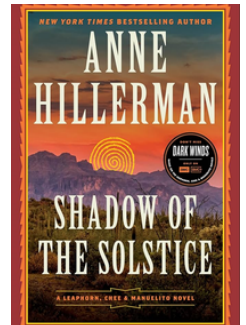

BALANCE & TONE CLASS!

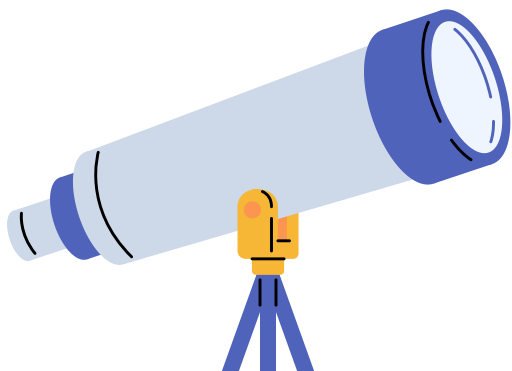

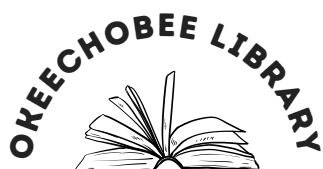

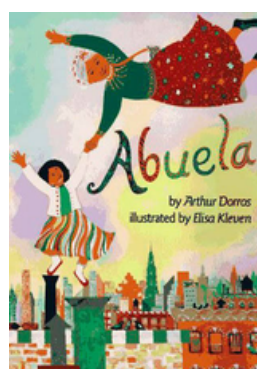


Frida's Cook

Sal can manipulate time and space, and Gabi uncovers his secret. Together, they must navigate parallel universes and confront the consequences of their actions.

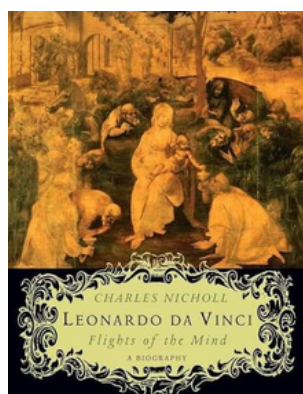


Abuela

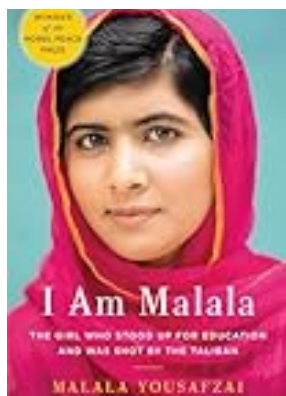


Leonardo da Vinci

In this engaging and thoroughly researched biography, Charles Nicholl uncovers the man behind the myth of the great Renaissance master.

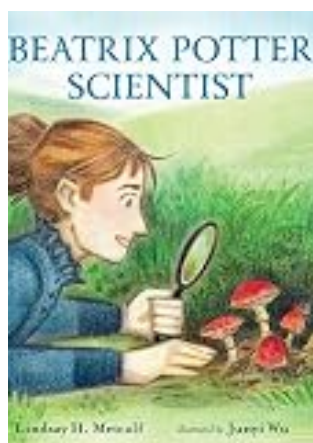
I am Malala

Malala Yousafzai shares her courageous journey of surviving a Taliban shooting while fighting for girls' education rights in Pakistan.

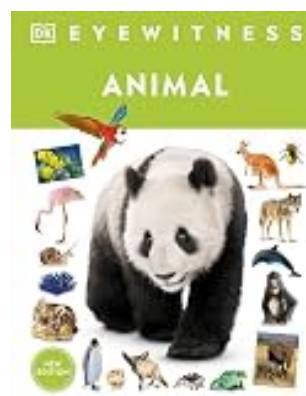


Beatrix Potter, Scientist

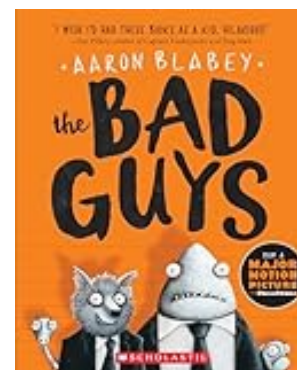


Animal
